Timeline of events



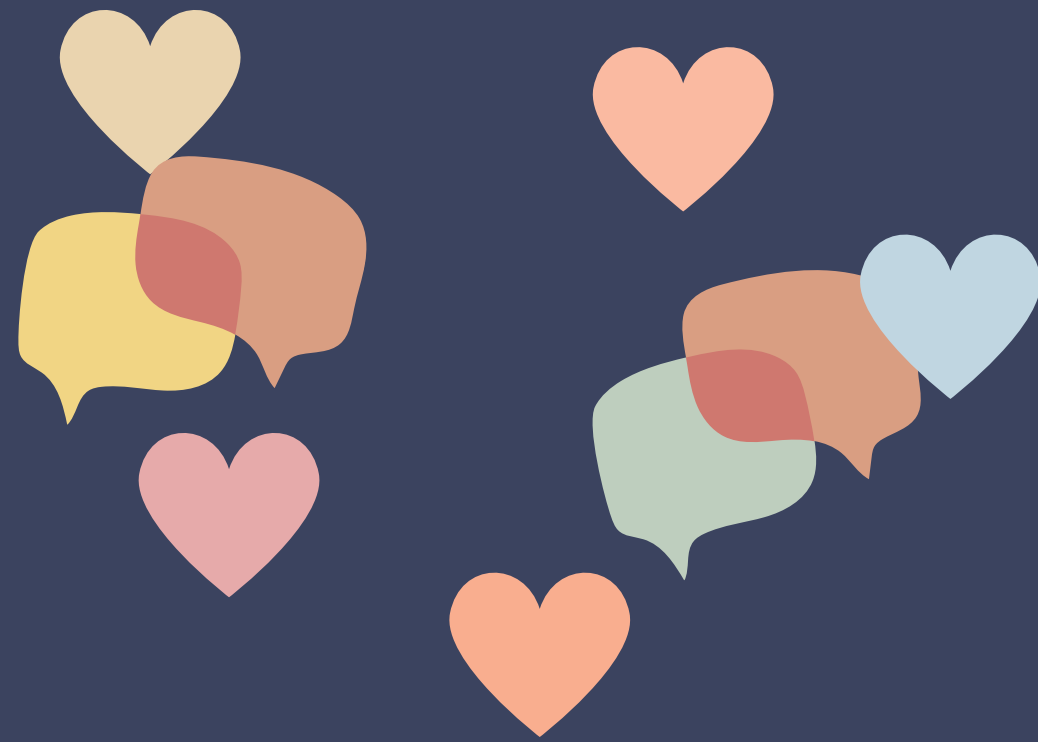
- **Day A: Write thoughts**

- **When the sync retro will be, and what will be discussed**

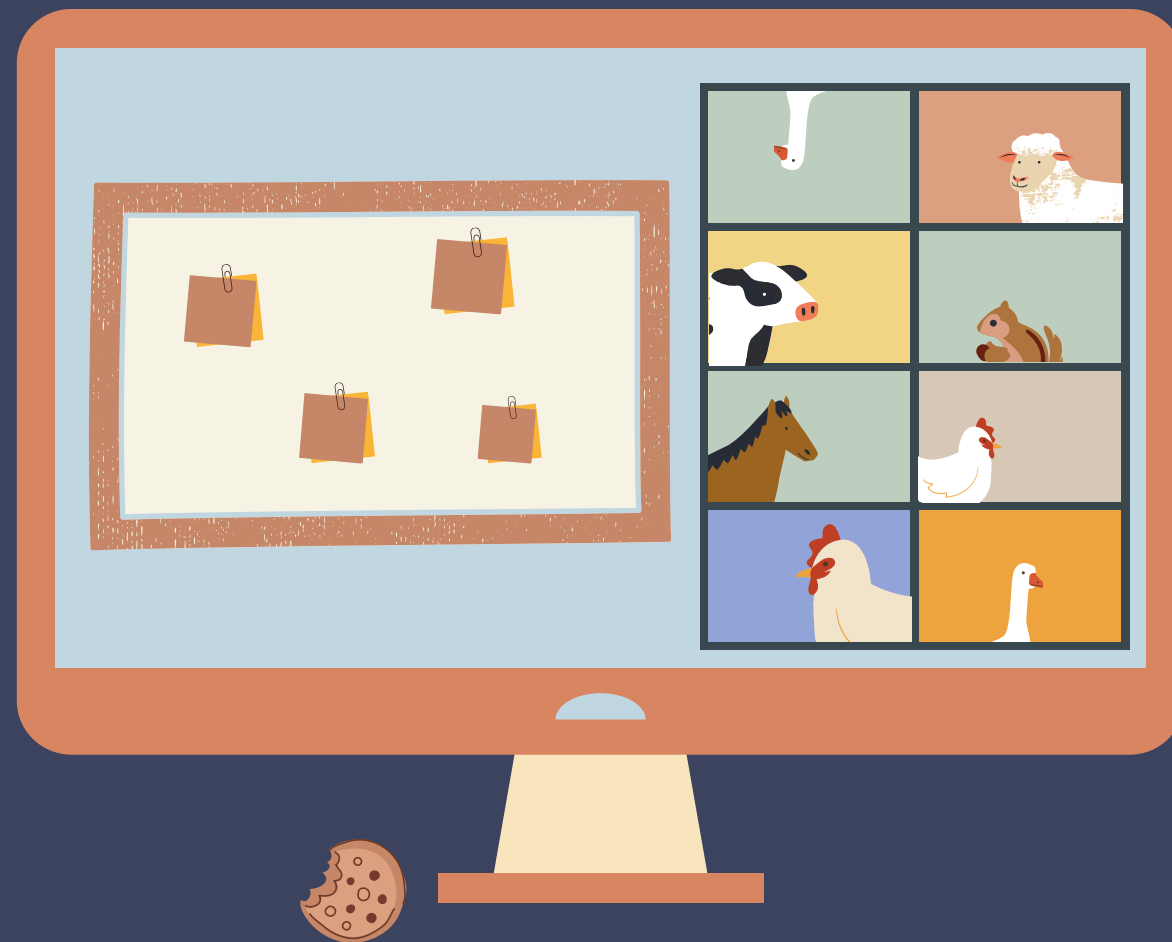


Expectations



- **Criticize things, not people**

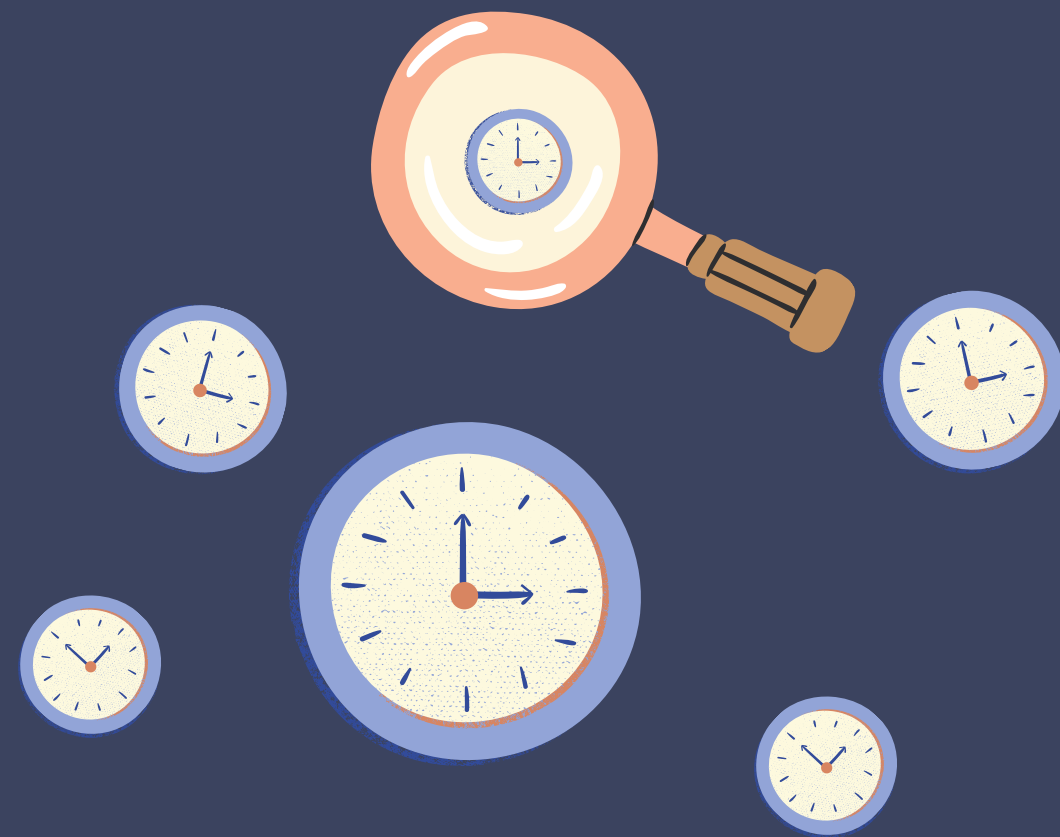


How to build an async meeting

run 100% asynchronously**

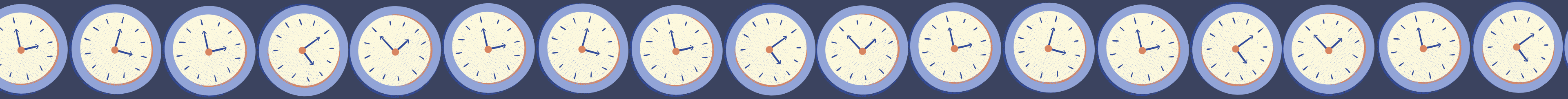


Determine which parts will be async



- **Information pushes**
- **Brainstorming**
- **Reading**
- **"Busy work"**

Create a timeline



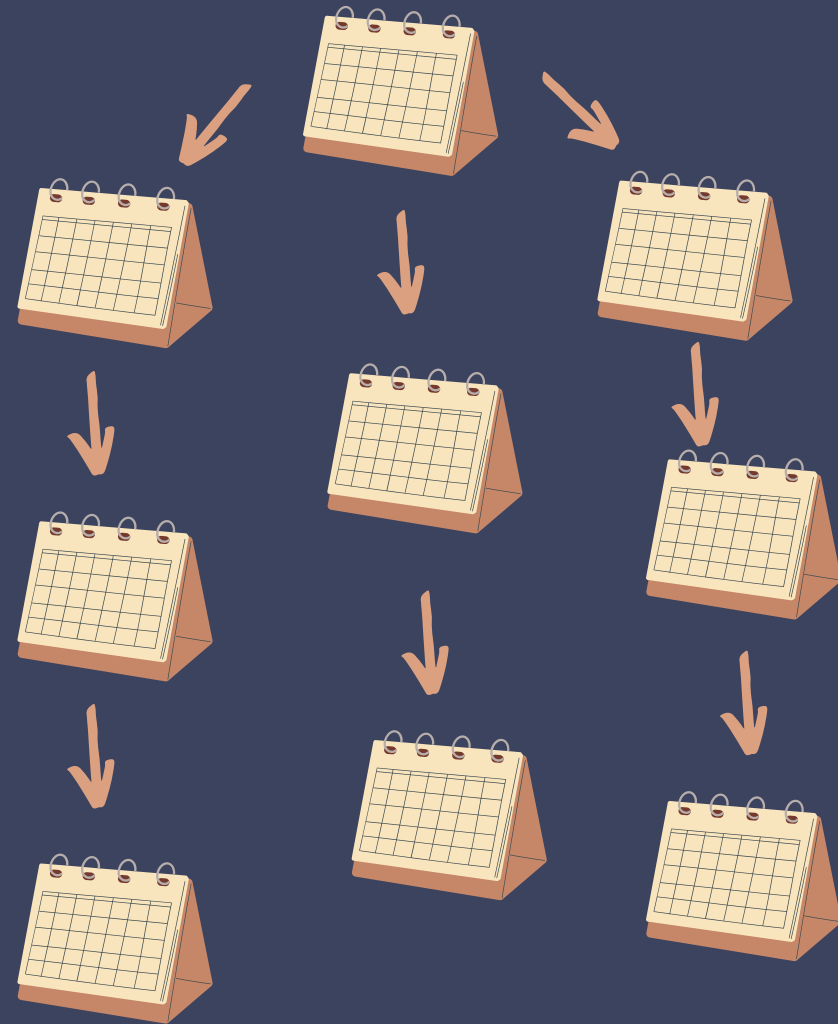
- **Deadline for each step**
- **Give enough buffer time**
- **Decide on sync meeting time (optional)**

Set and share an agenda



- **Expectations + timeline**
- **Easily accessible by all invitees**
- **Single spot for all information and discussions**

Benefits of async meetings



- **More time for thought**
- **Context is accessible**
- **Time zones**
- **Financial cost**

Benefits of sync meetings



- **Less coordination**
- **Real-time answers**
- **Fast-paced discussion**

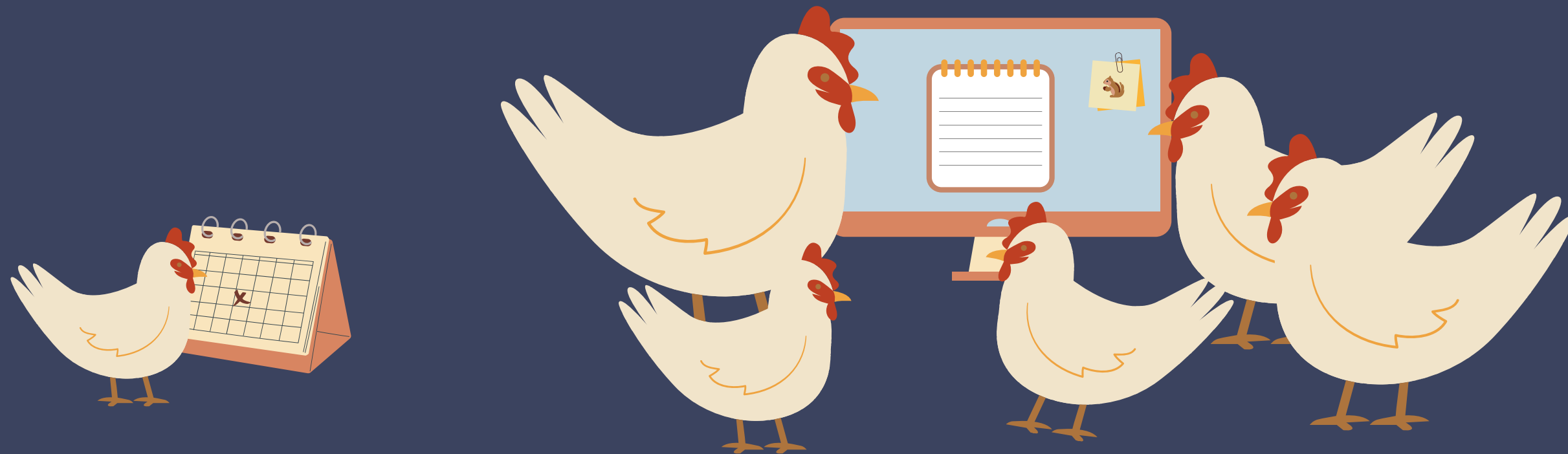
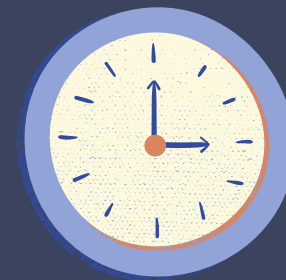

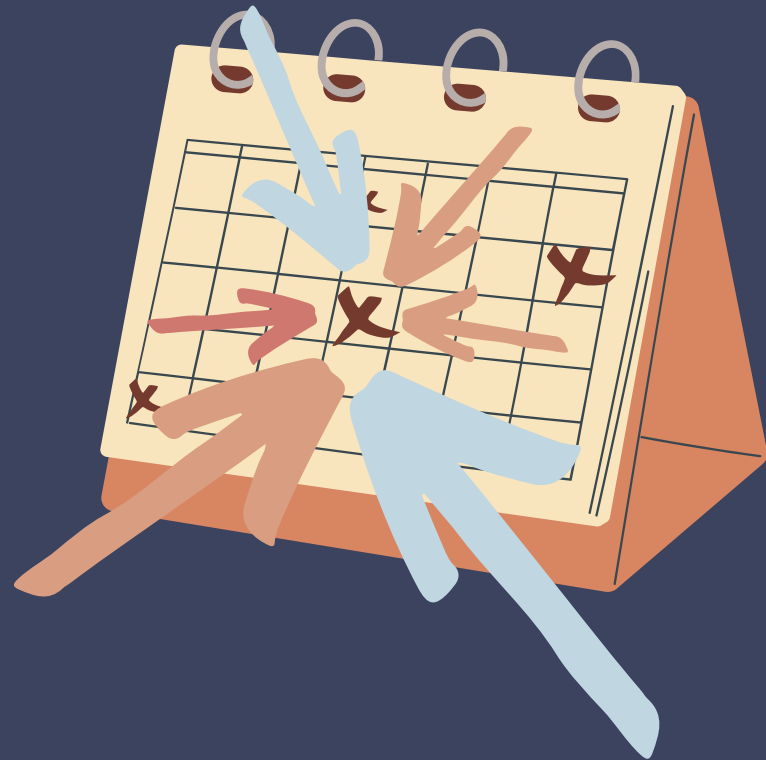
